The People of God journeying together

Beloved Sisters and Brothers,

Towards the end of the year 2021 and opening up to New Year of 2022, there are two important events happening in the Archdiocese of Jakarta. Firstly, the call of the Holy Father Pope Francis for universal Church for a Synod on Synodality. Secondly, the promulgation of five year Strategic Plan of the Archdiocese of Jakarta from 2022 to 2026.

1. A Church that Listens: A Call for a Synodal Church: Fellowship, Participation and Mission

The Church of God is convoked in Synod. With this convocation, Pope Francis on Sunday, October 10, 2021, formally launched the two-year global consultation process leading to the 2023 synod on synodality. Pope Francis invites the whole Church to question itself on synodality: a decisive theme for the life and mission of the Church.

What is a Synod? **'Synod'** is an ancient and venerable word in the Tradition of the Church, whose meaning draws on the deepest themes of Revelation. It indicates the path along which the People of God walk together.

First and foremost, synodality denotes the particular style that qualifies the life and mission of the Church, expressing her nature as the People of God journeying together and gathering in assembly, summoned by the Lord Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit to proclaim the Gospel.





The entire People of God shares a common dignity and vocation through Baptism. All of us are called in virtue of our Baptism to be active participants in the life of the Church. In parishes, small Christian communities, lay movements, religious communities, and other forms of communion, women and men, young people and the elderly, we are all invited to listen to one another in order to hear the promptings of the Holy Spirit, who comes to guide our human

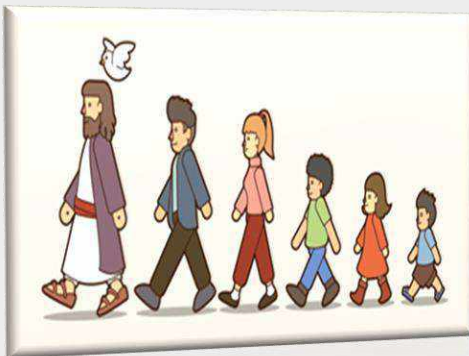
efforts, breathing life and vitality into the Church and leading us into deeper communion for our mission in the world. As the Church embarks on this synodal journey, we must strive to ground ourselves in experiences of authentic listening and discernment on the path of becoming the Church that God calls us to be.

While recent Synods have examined themes such as the new evangelization, the family, young people, and the Amazon, the present Synod focuses on the topic of synodality itself. The current Synodal Process we are undertaking is guided by a fundamental question: How does this *“journeying together”* take place today on different levels (from the local level to the universal one), allowing the Church to proclaim the Gospel? and what steps is the Spirit inviting us to take in order to grow as a synodal Church?



Three themes: Fellowship, Participation, Mission

Fellowship: By his gracious will, God gathers us together as diverse peoples of one faith, through the covenant that he offers to his people. Together, we are inspired by listening to the Word of God, through the living Tradition of the Church, and grounded in the *sensus fidei* that we share. We all have a role to play in discerning and living out God’s call for his people.



Participation: A call for the involvement of all who belong to the People of God – laity, consecrated and ordained – to engage in the exercise of deep and respectful listening to one another.

Mission: The Church exists to evangelize. We can never be centred on ourselves. Our mission is to witness to the love of God in the midst of the whole human family.

2. Five Year Strategic Plan of the Archdiocese of Jakarta 2022 – 2026

Here is the formulation of the fundamental framework of the strategic plan:

Archdiocese of Jakarta, as a communion and a movement of the People of God, founded in Eucharistic Spirituality, strives to become more loving, more caring and more witnessing for the love of our nation; by implementing the values of the Social Teaching of the Church in all aspects of lives.

The thematic themes of each year are as such:

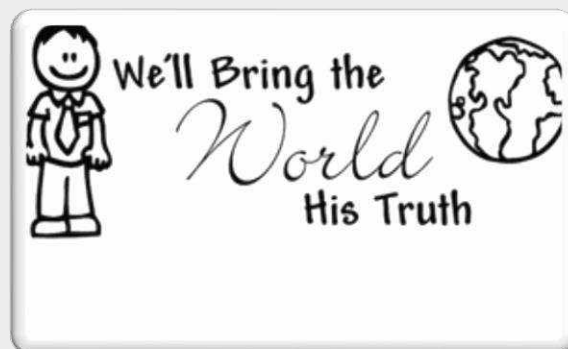
Year 2022: The Dignity of Human Being

Year 2023: Common Good

Year 2024: Solidarity and Subsidiarity

Year 2025: Care for the Poor and the Marginalised

Year 2026: Integrity of Creation



In each year, the implementation will be focused on five priorities of pastoral activities: Family, Youths, Liturgy and Evangelisation, Caderization and Lay Apostleship, and Digital Ministry.



We hope that the year 2022 onward will become the year of recovery and strengthening of our faith as we journey together with all people in overcoming the impact of the pandemic.

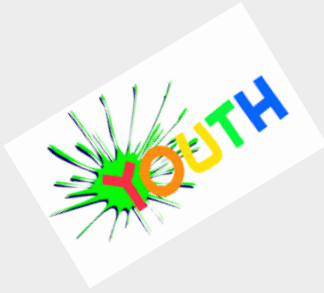

Reflection #1 By Rachel – ACS Jakarta

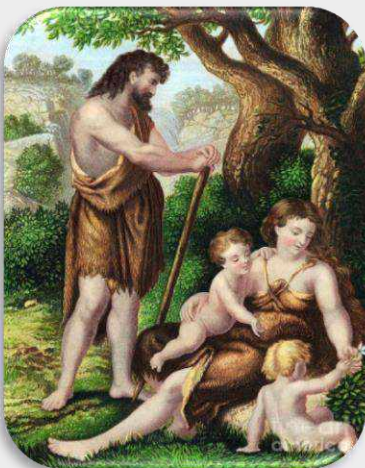
Today's YF was delivered by Fr. Albertus Joni, SCJ and focused on the Theology of the Body which mainly talked about the appreciation of our true image. Men and women are created by God to complement each other, and men and women are created with a body (and a different one) for a reason. Our body defines our identity. In Genesis 1:27, it is stated that **'God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them'**. - How do you cling to true love?
